

Declaration of the „conflict-minerals”

Dear Customers!

The U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) draft regulations to implement the Conflict Mineral Law, published in the Federal Register of December 23, 2010 would have required U.S. and certain foreign companies to report and make public their use of so-called "conflict minerals": columbite-tantalite, also known as coltan (from which tantalum is derived); cassiterite (tin); gold; wolframite (tungsten), from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries in their products, and declare about how they ensure that armed groups that abuse human rights can't profit from their mineral buying.

In this declaration, we would like to inform you as a partner of the HAFNER Pneumatika Kft. that we manufacture our products only from parts and materials that we procure from qualified and reliable suppliers. We require invisibility and traceability from our suppliers, moreover many manufacturers and suppliers indicate on their website the materials source of supply and origin.

Our company is not involved in direct importation of minerals, such as the "conflict-minerals", besides periodically we ask our suppliers for declaration about the fulfilment of the compliance with the regulation. During new supplier selection, we only choose the ones who meet this requirement.

Based on this, we declare that we do not have products manufactured or traded with parts or materials that contain "conflict-mineral" from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries.
